THE DECREES OF THE RABANAN AGAINST
WEARING ORNAMENTS INTO RESHUS HA'RABIM ON SHABBOS

(A)
THE GEZEIRAH

- 1) Perhaps she will need to immerse in a Mikvah, and she will remove the ornament and carry it in Reshus ha'Rabim
- 2) Perhaps she will remove it to show to her friend
- 3) Perhaps it will break off and one will carry it in Reshus ha'Rabim
- 4) Perhaps it will break off, and the slave will fold up his garment to hide the place where the badge was
- 5) Perhaps he will take it off and carry it, so that people will not know that he is a slave
- 6) It appears as though one is taking his animal to the marketplace

(B)
THE OBJECT THAT IT PROHIBITS

Woolen threads, linen threads, and straps worn in her hair, Chabakin on her neck

Totefes, Sarvitin (that are not sewn to the Sevachah), Kevul, Ir Shel Zahav, Ketala, Nezamim, etc.

A metal badge, bell, or ornament that is not sewn to one's garment

A slave's badge which is sewn to his garment and which his master made

A slave's badge made of clay, hung around his neck and which he made for himself (see Tosfos DH b'Mai)

A bell sewn to the garment of one's animal (54b, and Tosfos there)
