



Inside the Daf

Many people decorate a סוּכָּה to beautify it for the holiday. Maybe

you have made pictures, or color-ful chains to adorn a סוֹכָּה.

You may be surprised to learn that this is a very ancient custom.

The גמרא lists different decorations that were used at that time to

beautify a סוּכָּה: Colored cloths and embroidered linens with embossed designs. Hanging nuts, almonds, peaches and pomegranates. Clusters

of grapes and bundles of grain ears. Glass bottles of oil, wine, fine flour.

If the decorations hang lower than 4
רַב חִסְדָּא from the roof (about 14 in, or 36 cm), רַב חִסְדָּא and רָבָּה בַּר רַב הוּנָא say it is like the person sitting

underneath is sitting under a tent and not a סוּכָּה. He therefore would not fulfill the סוּכָּה of sitting in a סוּכָּה.

סוּכָּה of sitting in a סוּכָּה. בר נַחְמָן says you would still fulfill your

obligation to sit in a סוּכָּה because anything hung for decoration isn't like a tent covering.



People involved in doing a מָצְוָה are not required to eat inside a סוּכָּה at the same time. (This is true only when it would be impossible to do both – תוספות)


The teacher concluded, "Whenever you have a chance to observe how a refined person behaves, take every opportunity to learn from their actions."


Tent-vs.—Canopy

Is one allowed to sleep inside a tent that is inside a סובָה?

The מִּשְׁנָה says that one who sleeps in a canopied bed that is underneath a סוּכָּה hasn't sat inside the סוּכָּה. Rather, it is like the person is sitting under a tent in which case he isn't fulfilling the מִצְּוָה of sitting in a מִצְּוָה If the bed is within 10 טְּבָּהִים from the ground (about 3 ft or 1 m), it is not like a tent, and one who sits inside it is considered to be sitting inside a proper סוּכָּה.




What if someone sits inside a tent-like bed that is under a אָפָרָי? The מִּשְׁנָה says that it is as though the person is sitting inside the סוּבָּה. Rashi explains that this is because the tent peak is not really a "roof", but rather, like extra walls. Only a tent with a "roof", that is, a covering at least one אַפַּח wide (3.5 in/9 cm), is a structure that would be independent of the סוּבָּה overhead. One who sits in such a structure is not considered to be sitting in a אַבָּה.
