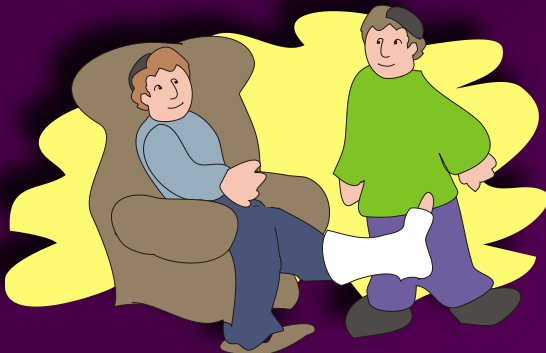

## Inside the Daf

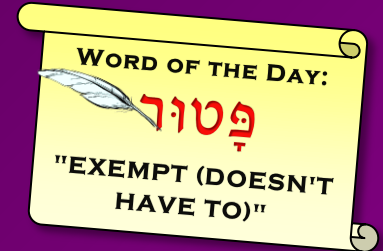
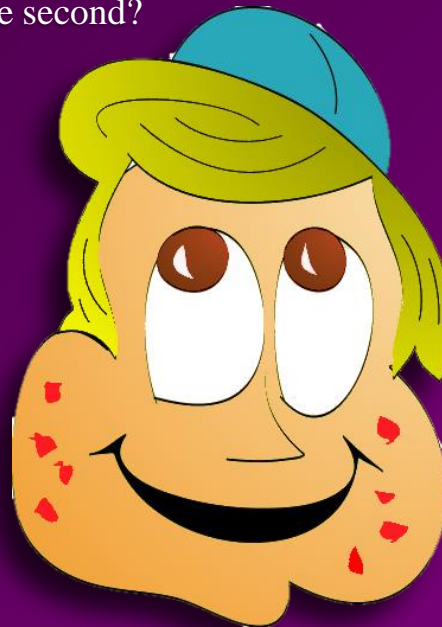
Have your parents ever told you to do a task and while you were in the middle of doing it – they asked you to do something else?



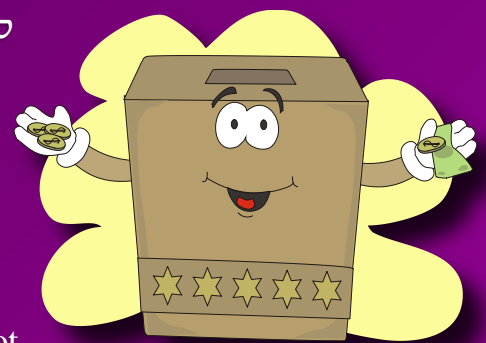
What happens if you are doing a מצוה (commandment) and then *another* מצוה comes up? Do you drop the first one to do the second?



Our משנה talks about people who are on a "מצוה mission," for example, they are travelling to study Torah, to greet their Torah teacher or to rescue a captive. Even when they come to rest at night they



do not need to sleep in a סוּפָה since they are busy thinking about doing their first מצוה properly.



This rule – that someone involved in one מצוה does not

drop it in order to do another – is called "הַעוֹסֵק בְּמִצְוָה פְּטוּר מִן הַמִּצְוָה", or, "one who is occupied doing a מצוה is exempt from another מצוה."
