Since the בְּרִית מִילָה (commandment) of בְּרִית מִילָה (circumcision) is so important, it is surprising to learn that the בְּיֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל (Children of Israel) who were born in the desert on their way from Egypt to the land of Israel were not circumcised the entire time they were in the desert! Why did they not perform this important מִצְוָה

The גְּמָרָא explains that the north wind did not blow for the Children of Israel for the whole time that they were in the desert. Rashi explains that the north wind is a mild one, not too hot and not too cold. This wind causes the clouds to disperse allowing the sun to shine through. The sun's rays heal the wounds of a בְרִית מִילָה, but were not available while the Children of Israel were in the desert. Without these rays, a מָילָה would be a dangerous procedure so they forwent circumcision while they were in the desert.

בּרִית-מִילָה-Time-of-Day

Have you ever been to a בְּרִית מִילָה? If you have, you probably went during the daytime and not at night.

The Torah says that "on the eighth *day*" the יויקרא is performed (see בְּרִית מִילָה, Lev. 12,3). This teaches that a בְּרִית מִילָה is done during the day and not at night.

The אָמָרָא teaches that not only is a baby boy

circumcised during the day, but also others who need a בְּרִית מִילָה. For example, men who convert to Judaism need to have a בְּרִית מִילָה performed when they convert. Their בְּרִית מִילָה, too, must be done during the day.

What if a baby could not be circumcised on the eighth day after his birth because he was sick? When he has his circumcision later, must it be done during the day?

This is a dispute between תַּנָּא קַמָּא, who says it must be done by day, and רַבִּי אֶלְעָזָר who holds that only a בְּר שִׁמְעוֹן done at its right time (on the eighth day) must be done by day.
