Inside The Daf



The Torah says that the כהן גדול who performs the עבודה (Temple service) on יום כפור must have a "household." The גמרא explains that this means he must have a wife. A כהן גדול who is not married may not perform the עבודה.

But what happens if his wife dies while he is performing the עבודה? Because of this concern, רבי יהודה requires another wife to be arranged for the כהן גדול before יום כפור in case his own wife dies.

The רבנן (Rabbis) do not require another wife to be arranged for the כהן גדול, because it is unlikely that his first wife will die during the short period of time he is performing the עבודה. The רבנן argue that if we set aside a second wife for the כהן גדול, why not set aside a third, fourth or fifth wife for the כהן גדול in case all of the other wives die!

Rather, say the רבנן, a second wife need not be set aside for the כהן גדול.

A Mourning פֿהן גָדוֹל



Our גַּמְרָא discusses the rules of a פֿהן גָדוֹל who is an אוֹנֵן.

An אוֹנֵן is someone who had one of his seven closest relative die that day.

An אוֹנֵן who is a regular פֿהן may not perform the עֲבוּדָה in the בַּיִת הַמִּקְדָּשׁ (Holy Temple).

A פֿהן גָדוֹל still performs the עֲבוּדָה even if he is an אוֹנֵן. He may not, however, eat from the sacrifices. (No אוֹנֵן -- even a פֿהן גָדוֹל -- may eat from sacrifices, תְּרוּמָה (tithe) or מַעֲשֵׂר שֵׁנִי (second tithe).

רַבֵּי יְהוּדָה says that a פֿהן גָדוֹל who is an אוֹנֵן still may not perform the עֲבוּדָה all day for fear that he may accidentally eat from the sacrifices with which he is working.
