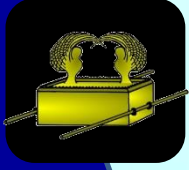

What's Missing?

The First Temple (בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ) stood until it was destroyed by the Babylonians. The Second Temple was destroyed by the Romans. These two Temples were very similar but also had some differences. Our גְּמָרָא lists some things that were missing from the Second בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ:



- 1) The אָרוֹן (Ark)
- 2) The כַּפֹּתֶת (Lid of the Aron)
- 3) The כְּרוּבִים (Cherubs)
- 4) שְׁכִינָה (Hashem's Presence)
- 5) רוּחַ הַקֹּדֶשׁ (Holy Spirit of prophecy)
- 6) אֲוִרִים וְתוּמִים (The letters on the כֹּהֵן גָּדוֹל's breastplate didn't light up to answer to questions from the כֹּהֵן גָּדוֹל)
- 7) The fire that came down from Heaven onto the מִזְבֵּחַ (Altar) didn't help burn the קִרְבָּנוֹת (Sacrifices).



Did You Know...

In the First בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ the Heavenly Fire that came down to the מִזְבֵּחַ looked like it was crouching like a lion. In the Second Temple it was crouching like a dog.

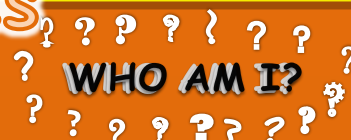
