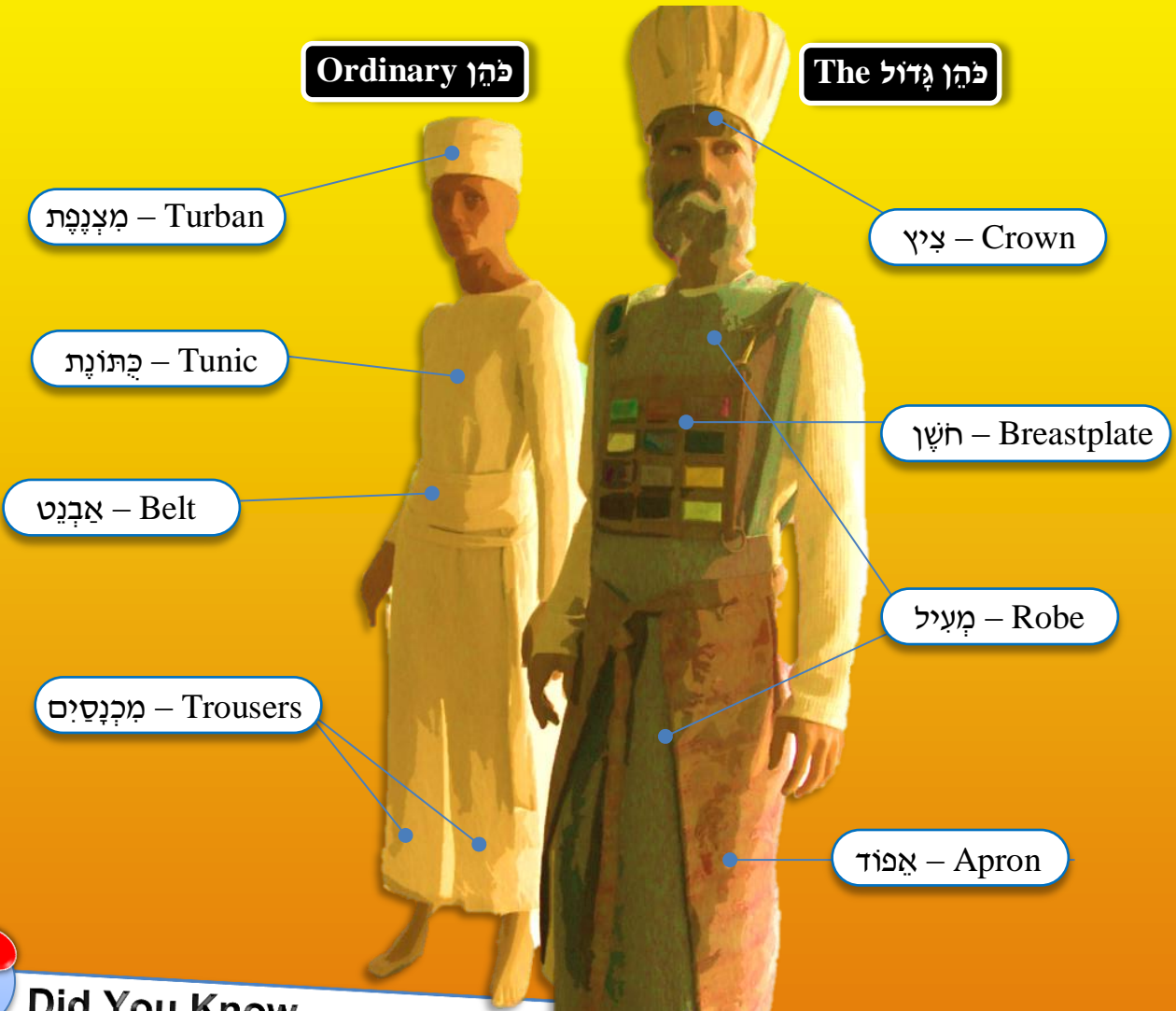

## Inside the Daf

When an ordinary פֶּהוֹן worked in the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ (Holy Temple), he wore four pieces of clothing.

A פֶּהוֹן גָּדוֹל would also wear these four pieces of clothing but he would also wear an extra four pieces of clothing.

The גְּמָרָא teaches that most of the פֶּהוֹנִים's clothing was made from linen.



### Did You Know...

When דָּוִד הַמֶּלֶךְ (King David) was on the run hiding for his enemies, he prayed he should walk before Hashem "in the lands of the living," (see Psalms 116:9: תהילים קטו: ט). What did he mean? רַב יְהוּדָה explains, דָּוִד was praying to be in a place near markets where he could buy everything he needed to live.

"You're a כהן, right?"

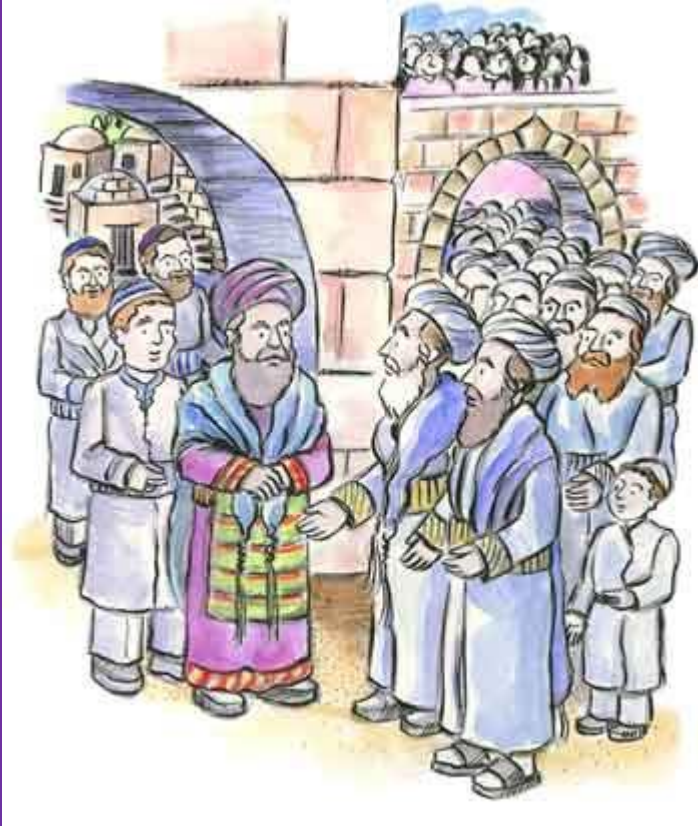
"You know I am," said Noah.

"So you're familiar with the special clothing the כהנים and the כהן גדול wore, right?"

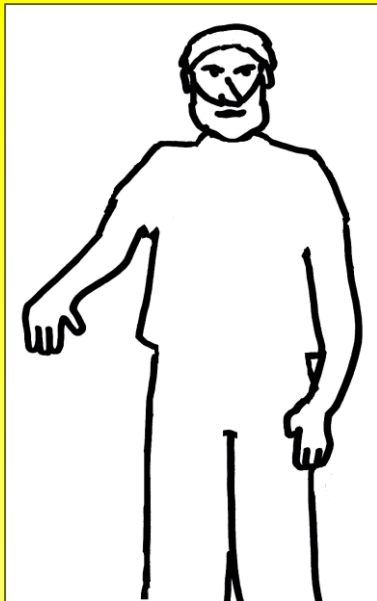
"Of course!"
